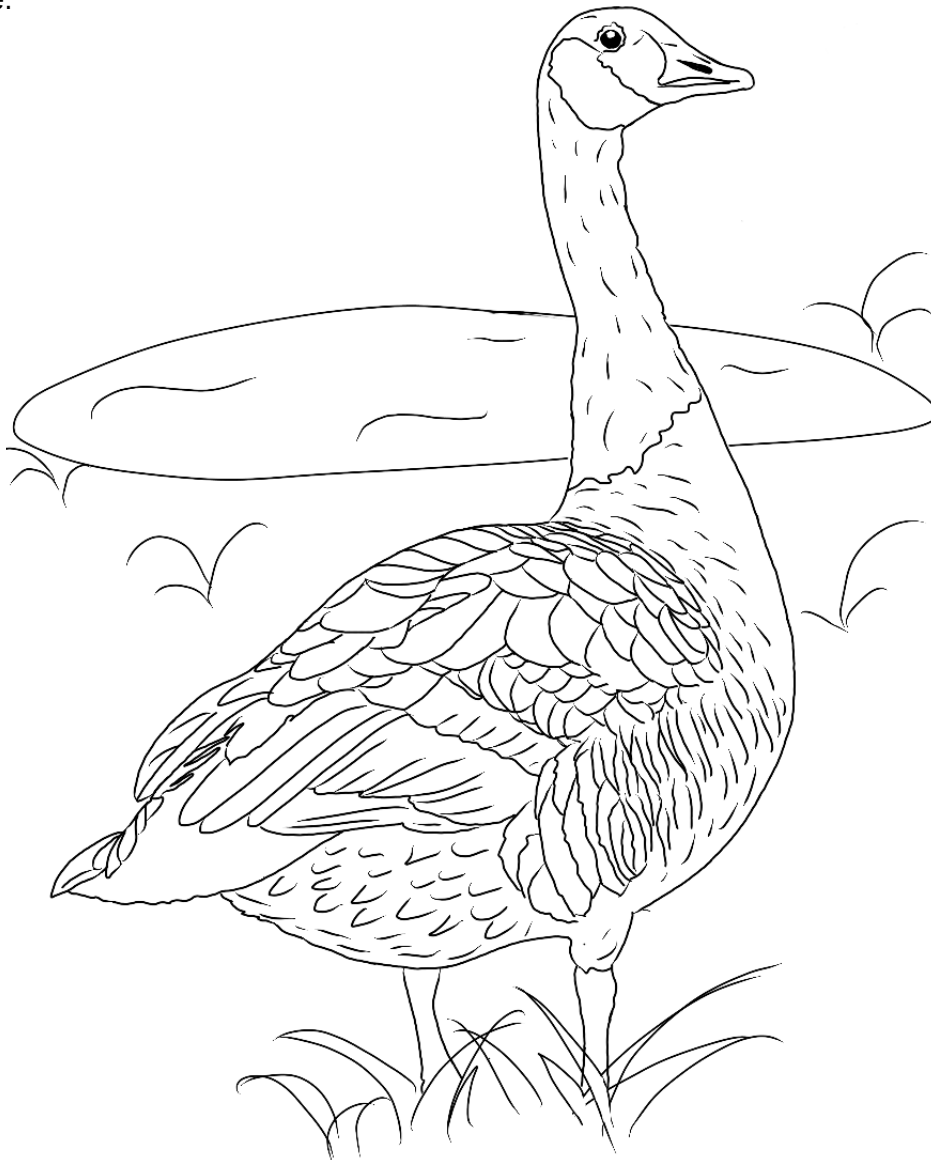


Canada Goose

Branta canadensis

The Canada Goose is a large goose species native to the arctic and temperate regions of North America. However, due to introduction, they can be found as far away as New Zealand, Argentina and the Falkland Islands. They are primarily herbivores, feeding on green vegetation and grains. They are considered a “pest species” in some parts of their range due to their ability to adapt and survive in human and urban spaces. These geese are also monogamous with most couples staying together their whole life.
