Mitchell County native Waymon Cross was raised near the Flint River and has a deep love and respect for its beauty. Since retiring five years ago, Cross has been capturing the Flint's beauty in stunning digital photography.

The Flint River in Photographs, an exhibition of 25 of Mr. Cross' hand-selected images, opens at the Flint RiverQuarium on Saturday, May 29, 2010. The photographs range in size from 20" x 24" to large 4' x 6' photomurals. They capture the river during different seasons, following heavy rains and in the throes of droughts. In short, the exhibition reflects the many characteristics of the Flint River. The exhibition is included with paid admission to the Flint RiverQuarium.

The Flint RiverQuarium is southwest Georgia's premier aquarium, featuring more than 1,000 animals that call the Flint River watershed home.
