### **Flint RiverQuarium offers October special to churches**

Beginning this weekend and continuing for the rest of month, visitors can show a church bulletin at the Flint RiverQuarium and receive a free movie admission any Sunday afternoon in October with the purchase of a RiverQuarium ticket.

“The current film just opened October 2, so this is a great opportunity to see the latest big-screen offering at the Imagination Theater,” said Flint RiverQuarium CEO Scott Loehr.

The film, *Sea Monsters: A Prehistoric Adventure*, takes audiences on a remarkable journey into the relatively unexplored world of the “other dinosaurs,” those reptiles that lived beneath the water. Produced by National Geographic, the large-format movie takes the viewer from fossil digs to larger-than-life visions of predatory chases in shallow seas, immersing the audience in a rarely explored environment during the dinosaur age.

Church groups also will receive a 10% discount on any *Sleep With the Fishes* overnight stay booked during the month of October and used by December 31, 2011.

“Our *Sleep With the Fishes* program is very popular with church groups—especially youth groups,” said Vicki Churchman, who handles facility rentals at the Flint RiverQuarium. “Groups receive a guided tour, watch a movie and participate in planned activities with their own personal staff person before bedding down at the Blue Hole for an overnight stay. It is a unique opportunity to experience the RiverQuarium after-hours.”

The Flint RiverQuarium is southwest Georgia’s premier aquarium, featuring more than 1,000 animals that call the Flint River watershed home. The Flint RiverQuarium is located at 101 Pine Avenue in downtown Albany, Georgia. Regular operating hours are Monday-Friday 9 a.m.-5 p.m.; Saturday 10 a.m.-6 p.m.; Sunday 1 p.m.-5 p.m.
