

FLINT RIVER QUARIUM

Welcome to the Flint RiverQuarium! Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with the map of the RiverQuarium and Adventure Center. The stairway in the center of the RiverQuarium lobby will lead you to the beginning of the exhibits. If needed, there is an elevator near the Pine Avenue entrance. The restrooms and gift shop are located at the far end of the lobby. You will pass this area upon exiting the exhibits. We hope you enjoy your visit to the Flint RiverQuarium. 1. Skywater

"Skywater" is the Creek Indian name for a blue hole spring. Filled with 175,000 gallons of water, the RiverQuarium's blue hole spring is home to over 150 fish, several turtles and even a few alligators.

2. Flint River Gallery

The Flint River Gallery follows the journey of the Flint all the way to the Gulf of Mexico.

3. Hatchery

In the hatchery we raise fish from eggs to fingerlings. After growing to a considerable size, they will be moved to other exhibits within the RiverQuarium.

4. Clues to the Past

Millions of years ago, Georgia was at the bottom of the ocean. In the layers of sediment and rocks along the river, you may find clues to the past from those who once called the banks of the Flint River home.

5. Blue Hole Rampway

Follow this rampway down to the source of the blue hole for a glimpse into the underwater world.

6. Discovery Caverns

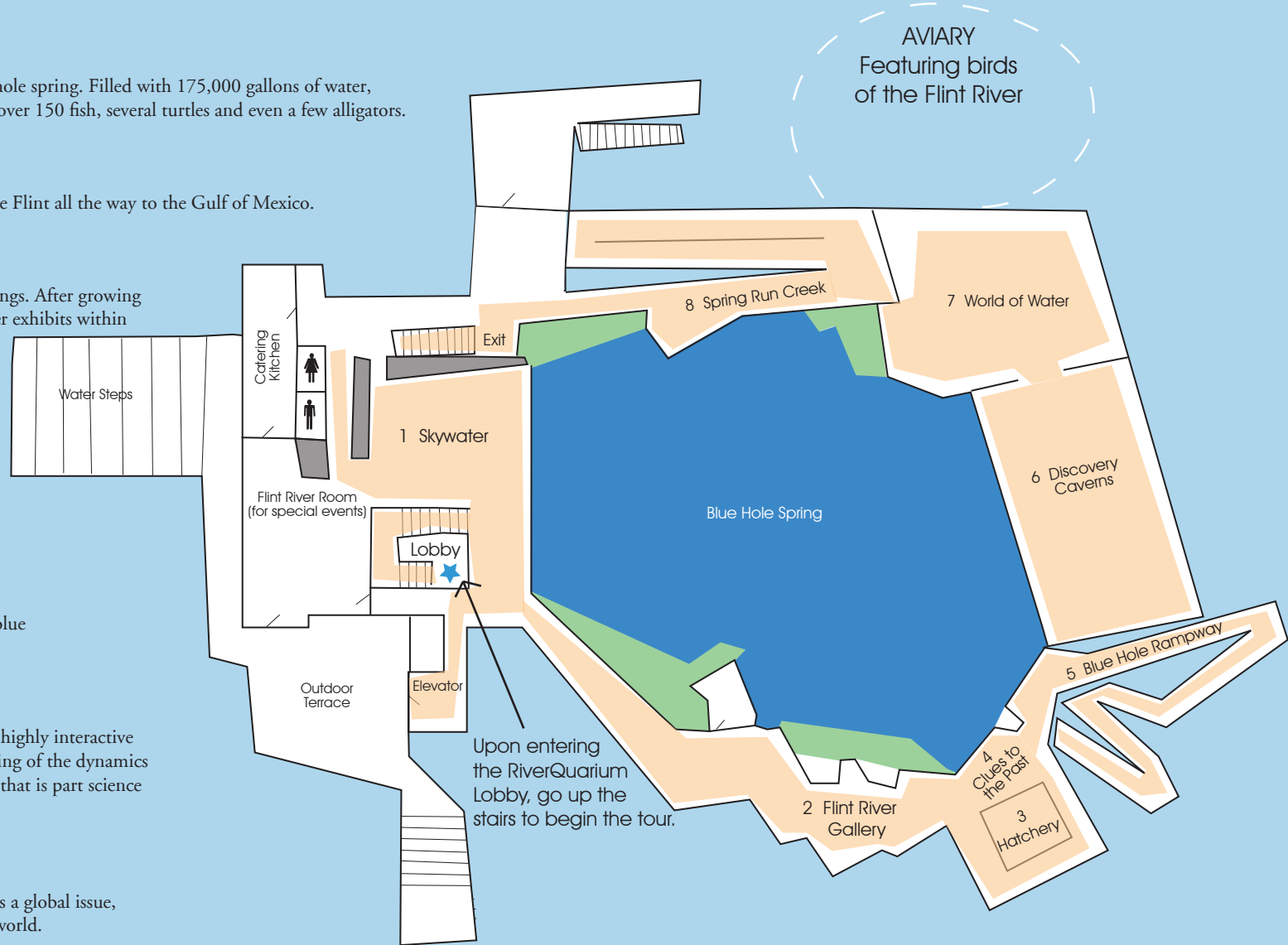
Discovery Caverns presents a series of hands-on, highly interactive exhibits that help to develop a better understanding of the dynamics of water, river systems and the aquifer in an area that is part science center and part children's museum.

7. World of Water

This exhibit area is designed to show that water is a global issue, illustrated by exhibits of rivers from around the world.

8. Spring Run Creek

Spring Run Creek, home to American Alligators and various fish, is formed by the blue hole's water winding its way to a river.
